Dear Colleagues:

In the past weeks we have received several requests to arrange scientific expeditions in Argentine territory for the Total Solar Eclipse of December 14, 2020. Given these requests, we would like to provide you with information about the situation in our country. As you may know, COVID-19 cases are still increasing in Argentina, and the health system is near saturation. External borders are closed to tourism, whereas internal borders (Argentina is a federal

country) are only partially open, mainly for essential activities. People gathering is restricted,

and social distancing is enforced. If this situation persists in December, it is highly improbable

that foreigners could enter the country without an official permit.

The Argentine Astronomical Society (the National Member representing Argentina

before the International Astronomical Union), the National Committee for Astronomy, and the

National Outreach Committe, want to bring this situation to your knowledge and recommend

that you proceed with your planned travel only if it is completely necessary.

In this case, we can offer you to transmit your request of an official travel permit to the

Ministry of Science of Argentina. If you are interested, please send us

(aaacd@fcaglp.unlp.edu.ar) the following information by September 26, in an official letter

signed by the authorithies of your institution:

1. Name, age, citizenship, and Passport number of all travellers,

2. Affiliation,

3. Scientific purpose of the travel, and instruments to be brought to the country,

4. Detailed travel plan (dates, flight and lodging information, observing location, etc.).

We would like to stress that we will solely take into account requests made by **foreign** groups wanting to perform **research activities related to the eclipse**, and that **we cannot ensure that the permit will actually be granted** by the Argentine Government. We would also like to stress that, given the COVID-19 crisis, **we cannot assume any responsibility regarding research expeditions**, **including but not restricted to health care**, **customs clearing**, **lodging**, **travelling within the country**, **or logistics**.
